## Editorial Note

The Federal Secretary for Energy (Petroleum Division), Dr. Arshad Mahmood recently visited SNGPL Head Office and held a meeting with Senior Management of the Company. MD SNGPL Ali J. Hamdani briefed him about the ongoing activities of the Company. During his visit, MD SNGPL apprised him about the consumption of natural gas in different sectors of the economy. Senior Management of the Company briefed the Federal Secretary about the latest technologies being used by the Company in managing day to day operations. Moreover, demand and supply situation was also discussed during the meeting highlighting that the major chunk of gas now sold by the Company is RLNG and not the indigenous system gas; which continues to decline at a rapid rate. A whole host of challenges faced by the Company including non-recovery of arrears on account of RLNG and pending issues in respect of TPA were also discussed in the meeting. Dr. Arshad Mahmood appreciated the role and commitment of Senior Management to make SNGPL a progressive organization and assured that Petroleum Division will be providing full assistance to the Company in resolution of critical issues.

SNGPL has earned profit after tax of Rs.5,917 Million and Earnings Per Share (EPS) of Rs.9.33 for the period ended December 31, 2020 as compared to profit after tax of Rs.4,696 Million and EPS of Rs.7.40 during the corresponding period of last year. Based on the declared profit, the Company has proposed an interim cash dividend of 20% i.e. Rs.2 per share for period ended December 31, 2020 which is a huge accomplishment. This speaks volumes about comprehensive change management program undertaken by the current management.

Recently, a three day Technical Session was held between Pakistan and Russia on Pakistan Stream Gas Pipeline Project. Both the parties deliberated on technical specifications, design parameters and transportation of RLNG from Karachi to Kasur. It was also agreed to sign a Shareholders Agreement (SHA) and Facilitation Agreement (FA) of worth about 2.5 Billion US Dollars. The Technical Session was concluded with a joint statement saying that the project has made a significant progress. It was also decided to expedite the process of planning, field surveys and other feasibility studies.

Corporate Briefing session of Sui Northern Gas was held at Pakistan Stock Exchange, Karachi. Managing Director SNGPL Ali J. Hamdani briefed the analysts, investors and shareholders about the Vision 2025, financial performance and future outlook of SNGPL. The analysts, investors and shareholders in large number attended the session through video conference facility and shown keen interest in the briefing conducted by the Company's team. The Managing Director highlighted the profitability of the Company which stood at Rs.6 Billion in FY 2019-20. The first quarter profitability for FY 2020-21 has increased to Rs.3.2 Billion as compared to Rs.1.9 Billion in the last year.

Orders for spot cargoes of RLNG have not been arranged by the suppliers to date which will add extra pressure on our gas supplies this winter.

I would also like to express my profound grief on the sudden and untimely demise of Muhammad Akhlaque Shaikh, General Manager (Telecommunications) on behalf of the Honourable Board of Directors, Management and the employees.

## SUI NORTHERN ANNOUNCES HISTORIC PROFIT OF RS. 6 BILLION

SNGPL has earned profit after tax of Rs.5,917 Million and Earnings Per Share (EPS) of Rs.9.33 for the period ended December 31, 2020 as compared to profit after tax of Rs.4,696 Million and EPS of Rs.7.40 during the corresponding period of last year. Based on the declared profit, the Company has proposed an interim cash dividend of 20% i.e. Rs.2 per share for period ended December 31, 2020.

Moreover, SNGPL has been able to earn historically high net profit amounting to Rs.8,939 Million for the period ended March 31, 2021 as against profit of Rs.5,779 Million during the corresponding period of last year. The earnings per share for the period under review is Rs.14.09 as against earnings per share of Rs.9.11 for the same period last year.

Despite all odds, including prevailing

Covid-19 situation the Company has been able to reduce the UFG losses during the periods under review, both in volumetric and percentage terms from 20,893 MMCF (10.39%) (Jul-Dec-19) to 15,011 MMCF (7.56%) (Jul-Dec-20) which has resulted into saving of Rs.2,819 Million to the Company which accumulated to Rs.4,137 Million by March 31, 2021 as a result of reduction of UFG losses from 33,935 MMCF (11.15%) (Jul-Mar-20) to 24,755 MMCF (8.45%) (Jul-Mar-21).

This substantial reduction in UFG losses was made possible due to joint concerted efforts of the Board of Directors and the Management alike. The Company is continuously striving to maintain the achieved momentum and is confident that performance of the Company will further improve in the years ahead.

## SUI NORTHERN'S CORPORATE BRIEFING SESSION HELD AT PSX

Corporate Briefing session of Sui Northern Gas Pipelines Limited (SNGPL) was held at Pakistan Stock Exchange, Karachi. Managing Director SNGPL Ali J. Hamdani briefed the analysts, investors and shareholders about the Vision 2025, financial performance and future outlook of SNGPL.



The analysts, investors and shareholders in large number attended the session and showed keen interest in the briefing conducted by the Company's team led by the Managing Director Ali J. Hamdani. Faisal Iqbal, Chief Financial Officer; Syed Jawad Naseem, SGM (Business Development); Qaiser Masood, SGM(Distribution) and





Imtiaz Mehmood, Company Secretary were also present. The Management briefed audience about the Company's vision and mission, history and its latest financial results. It was informed that Company's glorious history spans more than 50 years and is the largest downstream integrated gas Company serving more than 7 Million consumers through an extensive network of more than 145,000 kilometers in Punjab, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Islamabad and Azad Jammu & Kashmir. The Company's share in country's overall energy mix is around 30% while its share in gas sector is approximately 70% including supply of LNG to meet the energy demand of the country.

The Managing Director highlighted the profitability of the Company which stood at 6 Billion Rupees in FY 2019-20. The first quarter profitability for FY 2020-21 has increased to Rs. 3.2 Billion as



compared to Rs.1.9 Billion in the last year. This increase in profitability is due to interest rate reduction and significant reduction in UFG which shows relentless commitment of the Company towards a total turnaround of the Company.

MD SNGPL said that the country's indigenous supplies are continually decreasing and its gas supplies now comprise of around 55% RLNG. The dependence on RLNG will therefore continue to increase being cheaper than alternate fuels. Government of Pakistan is planning to introduce weighted average cost of gas which should mitigate and reduce the high price of RLNG for the public at large.

While briefing about the future outlook of the Company, the Management highlighted the Company's future vision and targets which included



diversification / integration of existing business, enhancing the use of modern technology to increase the efficiency, continuous upgradation and rehabilitation of gas infrastructure, improvement in Customer Services and complaints redressal through E-Kachehri. He talked about the digitalization initiatives being taken by the Company in order to facilitate the consumers at their doorsteps. He said that consumers can communicate their queries and lodge their complaints through the Company's Official Social Media Accounts. MD SNGPL also emphasized the importance of investing in Human Resource capacity building and gender diversity.

The briefing was followed by Question & Answer session in which all the queries were responded by the Managing Director and Senior Management in a very positive manner.




