## EXCELLENCE AND TEAM SPIRIT ON DISPLAY AS FAISALABAD (D) DEFENDS THE TITLE AT SNGPL SPORTS GALA - 2025

Annual Sports Gala 2025 was held in November 2025 at the Pakistan Sports Complex, Islamabad. Annual Sports Gala was held out of Lahore for the very first time. 352 male athletes from 22 SNGPL regional teams and 19 female players participated across a range of athletic and indoor events, creating a vibrant atmosphere of teamwork and healthy competition.

The Opening Ceremony was led by Faisal Iqbal (DMD - Services) as Chief Guest. Major General Irfan Arshad, HI(M) (Retd.), President Alpine Club of Pakistan attended the event as Guest of Honour, while Imtiaz Mehmood (Company Secretary / President SSC) and Zubair Ahmed Khan (President - CBA) warmly welcomed the distinguished guests. The Chief Guest started the Gala by lighting the torch. The players' oath was administered by Imtiaz Mehmood (Company

## SARGODHA (D) LEADS THE WAY IN DIGITAL TRANSFORMATION

In a major step toward operational excellence, Sargodha (D) has successfully shifted from the traditional cheque-based payment process to a fully Online Banking Portal - a milestone aligned with the company's vision of digitization and a paperless work environment.

This digital breakthrough has not only modernized the payment operations but has also created solid and measurable benefits for the organization and all stakeholders.

### KEY ACHIEVEMENTS AND BENEFITS

#### Faster Payments, Stronger Cash Flow

The previous process involved 3 to 4 days from preparation of Cheque to funds received by recipient due to traditional process of Cheque Dispatch and Interbank Cheque clearance. Now, payments are made instantly via Online Portal through IBAN, enhancing cash flow efficiency and improving stakeholder satisfaction by eliminating fund-waiting delay.

#### Routine Bank Visits

In the previous mechanism, a staff member was bound for this assignment to visit the banks once or twice daily for arranging transfer related to staff reimbursement and other affairs. However, with the new system, no regular bank visits are required, making the staff available for other official assignments that add far greater value to the

organization.

#### Clean and Effortless Bank Reconciliation

The digital portal has eliminated:

- Unpresented cheques
- Bank charges (due to FOC services)
- Entry timing differences

This means the Bank Reconciliation Statements are now clean, quick, accurate and saving significant staff time every month.

#### Real-Time and Zero Cost

The portal provides instant, real-time access to the regional fund position, enabling better decision-making, improved planning and stronger financial control.

Through effective negotiation, the portal was acquired completely free of cost (FOC), saving the organization's cheque book expenses and IBFT charges.

#### Management Support

This accomplishment was only possible through the guidance, encouragement and support from Regional Manager Sargodha (D), General Manager (Accounts) and Chief Financial Officer. Their support and guidance played a vital role to take this important digital leap confidently and effectively.

## CRYPTOCURRENCY

Cryptocurrency, sometimes called crypto-currency or crypto, is any form of currency that exists digitally or virtually and uses cryptography to secure transactions. It operates independently of a central authority, such as a government or a financial institution. It uses cryptographic techniques to secure financial transactions, control the creation of new units and verify the transfer of assets. This digital currency has gained popularity for its potential and provide more accessible and secure ways to conduct transactions globally.

Cryptocurrencies were initially designed to facilitate peer-to-peer transactions without the need for intermediaries like banks. Individuals can use cryptocurrencies to transfer funds directly to others across the globe. This offers fast and secure transactions, often at a lower cost compared to traditional banking systems. Cryptocurrencies like Bitcoin and Litecoin are commonly used for everyday transactions, online purchases and remittances.

Cryptocurrency uses public and private keys to secure transactions. The public key, similar to an account number, is shared with others to receive funds, while the private key, like a password, is kept secret and used to sign transactions. This cryptographic security ensures the integrity and authenticity of transactions.

### **Evolution of Cryptocurrency**

Since the inception of Bitcoin in 2009, cryptocurrencies have rapidly gained popularity and disrupted traditional financial systems. Bitcoin, created by an anonymous figure known as Satoshi Nakamoto, introduced the concept of blockchain technology - a distributed ledger that records and verifies transactions across a network of computers. Bitcoin's success paved the way for numerous other cryptocurrencies like Ethereum, Ripple and Doge. Each cryptocurrency has its own rules for how new coins are created and how transactions are verified. For example, in Bitcoin, miners use specialized computers to solve cryptographic puzzles, a process known as mining. This mining process secures the network, validates transactions and create new Bitcoins as a reward for miners.

### **The Concept of Decentralization**

Cryptocurrencies operate on decentralized networks, typically using blockchain technology. This decentralization means there is no central authority, such as bank or government. This reduces transaction fees and facilitates peer-to-peer transactions,

empowering individuals to have direct control over their finances.

### **Security and Transparency**

Blockchain technology, which underpins most cryptocurrencies, ensures that all transactions are recorded in a transparent and immutable ledger. Each transaction is encrypted and linked to the previous one, forming a chain of blocks (hence the name "blockchain"). This structure makes it extremely difficult to alter transaction data once it has been recorded, providing a high level of security and transparency. Users can verify transactions independently, fostering trust in the system.

### **Global Reach**

Cryptocurrencies are not bound by national borders and can be used globally, enabling seamless cross-border transactions and making them attractive for international trade and remittances. With cryptocurrencies, individuals can transfer funds internationally quickly and at a fraction of the cost compared to traditional methods.

### **Security and Privacy**

Cryptocurrency uses advanced cryptographic techniques to secure transactions, making them highly secure and resistant to fraud and hacking. Blockchain technology ensures transparency while maintaining privacy, as transactions are recorded on a public ledger without revealing personal information.

### **Investment Opportunities**

The cryptocurrency market has created new opportunities for investment. Early adopters of cryptocurrencies like Bitcoin have seen substantial returns on their investments, attracting more interest from both individual and institutional investors. However, the market is also characterized by high volatility and potential investors must be aware of the risks involved.

### **Integration with Emerging Technologies**

Cryptocurrencies are increasingly integrating with emerging technologies like decentralized finance (DeFi), non-fungible tokens (NFTs), and the Internet of Things (IoT). These synergies can unlock new opportunities and applications, revolutionizing various industries.
